37 Shanghai Fuxing Senior High School

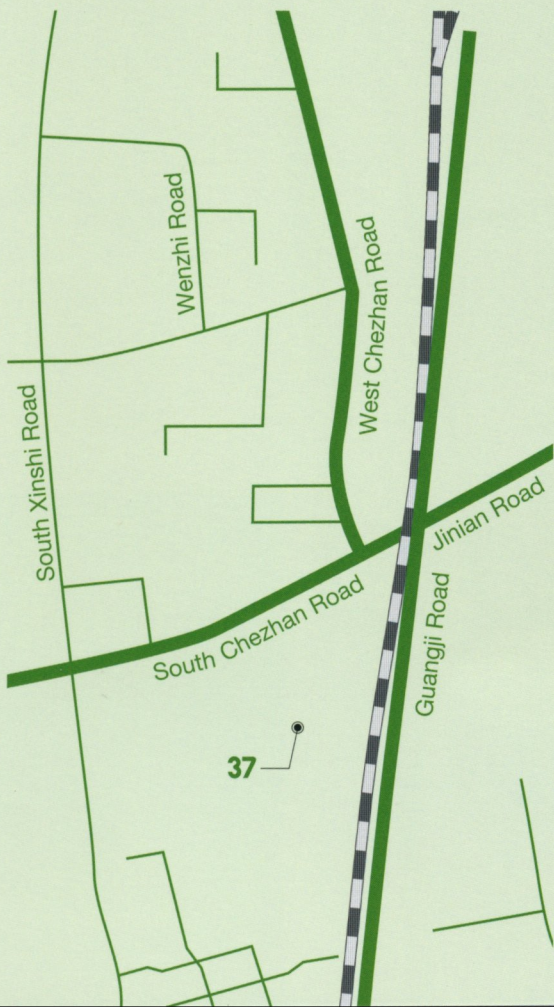
No. 28 South Chezhan Road

Located in north Hongkou District, Shanghai Fuxing Senior High School covers an area of more than 80 mu and has a construction area of 35,000 square meters. It's one of the first experimental and demonstrative boarding high schools in Shanghai.

The school chose "seeking truth" as its motto. In the past more than 50 years, "Fuxing

people" have always been assiduous, daring to explore and making great efforts to practice. Therefore, the Fuxing tradition and spirit of "Seeking truth", "Seeking knowledge" and "Being real" was formed. The school owns advanced facilities, has an excellent teaching quality and makes a remarkable performance in education. Over the years, its students have won many prizes in various national and municipal subject competitions. The school was announced as Shanghai Experimental and Demonstrative High school and awarded over 10 titles of honour on city level. The school focuses on developing the comprehensive ability of the students and fully demonstrating their individuality.

The school has been working actively in international exchanges. It has become sister school with many schools in Japan, America, Germany, Canada, Singapore, South Korea etc.



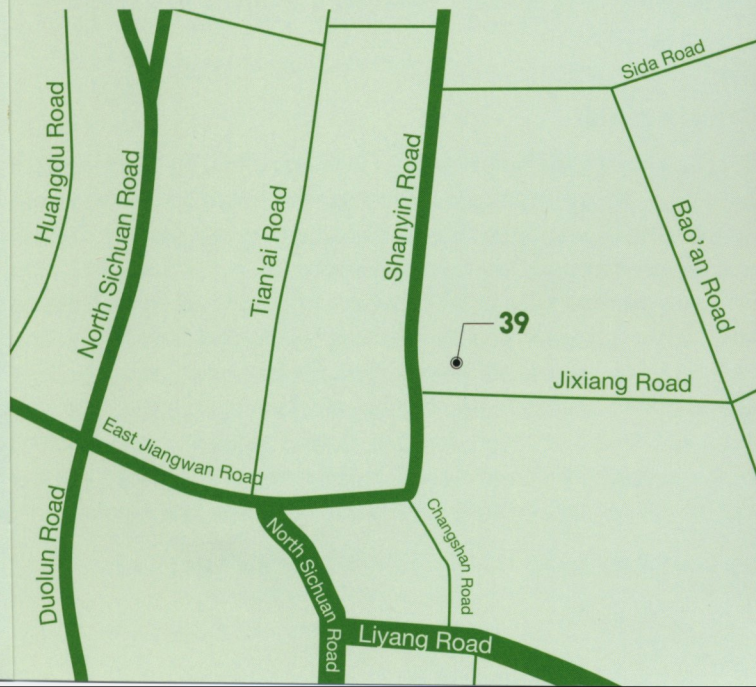
38 Shanghai Chengzhong Senior High School

No. 800 East Yuhang Road

Located at No. 800 East Yuhang Road in Hongkou District, Shanghai Chengzhong Senior High School has a history of over 100 years. It was founded in 1900 by a famous entrepreneur in Qing Dynasty, Ye Chengzhong. It was the first Chinese school with the class teaching system in Shanghai.

The first principal of Chengzhong High School, Cai Yuanpei, chose "honesty and simplicity" as the school spirit. Over a century, it has cultivated pillars of the society batch after batch, including nationwide and even worldwide famous scholars like Hu Shi and Zhu Kezhen.

Covering an area of 19,100 square meters, the school owns advanced teaching facilities and the largest classroom building in Hongkou District. Under the school philosophy of "Educating people as foundation and effective development" and the school motto of "Being sincere and seeking truth", it has gradually formed its own teaching characteristics and made a distinguished performance in education. Its students are comprehensively developed and have won many prizes in National Model Airplane Competition, Shanghai Basketball, Table Tennis, Handball and Chinese Chess Competitions.



39 Shanghai Hongkou No. 3 Central Elementary School

No. 103 Shanyin Road

Shanghai Hongkou No. 3 Central Elementary School is located at No. 103 Shanyin Road, close to the former residents of Lu Xun, Guo Moruo, Qu Qiubai and etc., thus situated in rich cultural surroundings. The school was formerly Shanghai No. 1 Senior Girl School, which was founded in 1920. In 1956, it was named Hongkou No. 3 Central Elementary School.

The school adheres to the educational philosophy of "Caring for all the students, advocating development of individuality". It has formed the school spirit of "Seeking truth, reality and creation" and the learning and teaching spirit of "Strict, practical, lively, happy and new". Due to its excellent education quality, the school has cultivated many mentally and physically healthy students with good moral and strong social adaptability.

The school is now Shanghai characteristic school of art education, Shanghai experimental school of education for all-around development and model school for students' code of conduct etc. Its art education is extraordinarily excellent. It was awarded various titles of honor many times respectively on national, city and district level.

40 Qu Garden

No. 246 West Dalian Road

Qu Garden was elaborately designed by the famous garden designer Prof. Chen Congzhou. With an area of 11,000 square meters, there are luxuriant vegetation, blooming flowers, small bridges, running water and winding corridors in the garden, simple but elegant. It has the distinctive characteristics of the gardens in the region south of the Yangtze River. The main buildings in the garden are Changshu Tang, "Home of Sunshine", Yongjun Yuan, Recovery Room and, Liushang Ting and etc.

In memory of the chief architect of China's reform and opening-up policy Deng Xiaoping's visit of Quyong Community in 1983, the people of the community spontaneously set up a bronze statue of Comrade Deng Xiaoping at the southern entrance of Qu Garden on Mar 21st, 2008.

The "Home of Sunshine" of Quyong Community is a comprehensive activity and training place for mentally disabled people, integrating 5 functions of rehabilitation training, Special Olympics, education and counseling, simple labor and career guidance. On Oct 1st, 2007, General Secretary of the CPC Central Committee, Hu Jintao visited the "Home of Sunshine" in person, celebrating the National Day with the community cadres, masses and Chinese and foreign Special Olympics athletes altogether.

41 Public Service Inn

No. 430 Yutian Road, No. 45 Huihe Road

In order to solve the problems of the residents' immediate concerns, the first Public Service Inn in Shanghai was established at No. 430 Yutian Road and opened to the public in January 2008. The Public Service Inn in Quyang Community, Hongkou has four stories. On the first floor is the branch for post service and public service of the government; on the second floor is the health service office of "Medical Insurance Hotline"; on the third floor is the day-care station for the elderly; on the fourth floor is the community canteen, which provides meals for the elderly, nearby residents and the white-collar in business buildings. Almost all public services closely related to the residents are included in this small "inn".

In November 2009, the Public Service Inn (North) at No. 45 Huihe Road was formally opened. Its main function is to provide living and cultural services, including public service, market-oriented service, charity service and residents' mutual-help service, covering nearly 30,000 residents in the surrounding area.



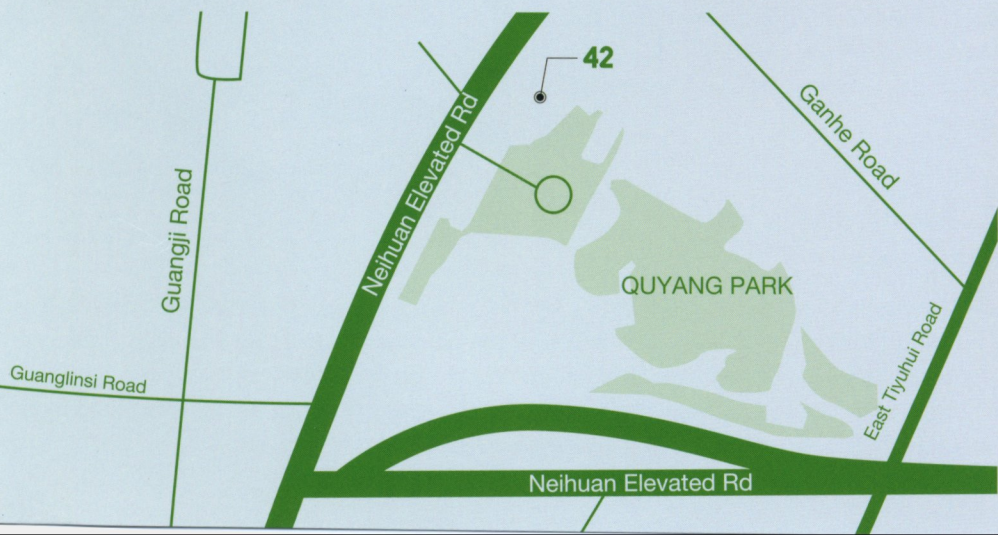

42 Cultural Center of Quyang Community
